### **Scottish Employment Tribunal President appointed**

The Lord President of the Court of Session has appointed Mrs Shona Simon as President of Employment Tribunals (Scotland).

Shona Simon is a solicitor who was appointed as a part-time chairman of the Employment Tribunals in 2000, before becoming a full-time chairman (now known as an Employment Judge) in 2002, and then appointed as Vice-President in 2004.
